MEMORIAL SERVICE OFFERED FOR THOSE LEFT BEHIND AFTER A SUICIDE

Painesville, OH — A special memorial service for those left behind after the suicide of a loved one is slated for Sunday, October 4 at Manry Park in Willowick.

The free, non-denominational service is hosted by Chrysalis, a support group for relatives and friends of suicide victims. It begins at 2:00 p.m., and is open to anyone whose life has been impacted by suicide. Manry Park is located at 30100 Arnold Drive in Willowick. For information or to RSVP, call 255-1700, ext 1237.

The “parent” organization for Chrysalis is the Lake County Suicide Prevention Coalition. Rae Grady of the Coalition says the service has been designed to help further the often difficult healing process for families and individuals. “Suicide can have an especially brutal impact on those left behind,” explained Grady. “It can be comforting to know that you’re not alone, that others are traveling the path toward healing along side you. That’s what this service is all about.”
